WORKING IN PROGRESS

The labor-supply behavior of physicians is an important determinant of the performance of any health-care system. One policy instrument which is available to improve efficiency is compensation design: the hospital decides a basic workload (threshold) that physicians will be compensated for exceeding the basic workload. We consider the decision problem to determine the optimal thresholds for different departments. We first analyze historical data using fixed effects OLS models to estimate physicians' workload per day and describe the impact of different factors on that. Next, we formulate an optimization model in which the hospital is allowed to determine different thresholds for different departments to minimize compensating wage differentials among different departments. Our model can help to improve the rationality of basic workload. The project is jointly

working with Huan Zheng, Huijuan Wang and Children's Hospital of Shanghai.
