<p><input type="checkbox"/> A copy of Passport page showing nationality and personal details for <u>International Applicants</u></p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> A recent passport-sized photograph</p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> A copy of CV</p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Research proposal/ Personal Statement of 1-2 pages.</p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> A copy of undergraduate and/or graduate degree scrolls</p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> A copy of Undergraduate and/or graduate degree transcripts</p> <p>Note: If any of the transcripts is not in English, it must be certified true copy with English translation.</p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Recommendations from two referees</p> <p>Note: The recommendations from the two referees are to be submitted directly via the online admission system. The referee can come either from the academic sector or from the industry sector.</p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> A copy of TOEFL/ IELTS score report</p> <p>Note: Applicants whose medium of university instruction is not in English must submit Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) as evidence of their proficiency in the English Language.</p> <p>TOEFL/ IELTS score reports are only valid for 2 years after the test and the validity period should not expire before the application period for the relevant intake for which they are applying.</p>

- A copy of **GRE** score report

Note:

With effect from AY2023/2024 (August 2023) intake, all PhD applicants are required to submit GRE score reports.

Applicants must obtain an aggregate minimum score of 320 for the Verbal (V) and Quantitative (Q) sections and a minimum score of 3.5 for the Analytical (A) section.

Exemption from the GRE requirements will be given to:

- Graduates from NUS/ NTU/ SUTD/ SMU who have graduated with Honors (Highest Distinction) and
- Final year students from NUS/ NTU/ SUTD/ SMU who are expected to obtain Honors (Highest Distinction).

Please note that the GRE scores are valid for five (5) years from the test date.

- For self-finance applicants, please include documentary evidence of financial support in the form of a bank statement and/or letter of confirmation from a sponsor.
